

Geography

As children work through our Geography curriculum they will know more and understand more about the world around them. A good geographical understanding relies on firm foundations of knowledge and skills. The skills our curriculum develops, like the knowledge, are specified and ordered coherently and progress over time. Pupils will deepen their understanding of physical and human geographical processes, fostering curiosity and fascination for the world we live in. Our geography curriculum equips pupils with knowledge about diverse places, people and environments. In arming children with powerful knowledge about the world around them, we help them to develop a love for the subject of Geography, and also recognise their own role in becoming a responsible global citizen.

Aims

Pupils will:

- Learn Geographical skills such as map work, interpretation of graphs and using co-ordinates.
- Understand more about their local area, the UK, Europe and the World.
- Gain an understanding of what Geographers do, what they look for and what they may say about a place.
- Use data from around the world, including from Geographical Information Systems, to understand social, economic and political globalisation.
- Have opportunities to reflect upon the advantages and challenges globalisation brings.
