Terms of reference:

- To be responsible for administering the Admission Policy, within statutory provisions and the governing body policy, including applying the admissions criteria if the school is over-subscribed
- To review annually the admissions policy in line with diocesan and local government guidelines and recommend the policy to the full governing body
- To consider the school's standard class size/intake per academic year
- The Committee will consider any application for admission that the Headteacher cannot determine in accordance with the school's Admission Policy
- When an application is refused for admission of a child to the school the Committee will ensure that the school informs the parent/guardian of the reason for refusal and their right to appeal against that decision
- The committee with the Headteacher is responsible for preparing and presenting the school's case in response to any parental/guardian appeals against the refusal of child's admission to the school.
- The Headteacher has delegated responsibility for all administration relating to the Admission's policy.
